3:50 – All student will meet in the main lobby of the Beth Emet banquet room to make sure we know what the set up plan is.

4:00 – Wind Ensemble, Aaron (on snare), possibly ROTC line up to run through the band marching in to a cadence, presentation of colors, and the playing of national anthem. While the national anthem run through is happening, rhythm section will set up outside where the jazz ensemble is to be. All rhythm section and chairs/stands must be set up. Percussion duet and sax quartet must also be set up.

4:30 – Jazz band warm up, tune, and hit a few spots.

5:00 – Wind Ensemble will have time to relax and eventually change into marching band FULL uniform and move to waiting area. Jazz band will have everything set by this time and ready to go. No playing till performance time.

5:25 – Jazz Ensemble is set ready to go.

5:30 – 'Cocktail Hour' begins and music starts.

6:20 – Wind Ensemble and ROTC line up out front in two's (performance order) ready to go.

6:30 – Banquet portion begins. Cadence, marching band, presentation of colors and national anthem.

6:40 – We are done with the performance. All must help collect and load equipment.

7:15 – Head back to school to unload and put everything away.
